

St Joseph's School ~ Renmark Animal Policy



POLICY:

St Joseph's School values a "safe, welcoming and happy environment" at our school. Due to the unpredictability of domestic animals, combined with the fears expressed by some children, it is essential that the presence of animals at school is controlled.

Mandatory Provisions:

All animals shall be banned or prohibited from entering the school site.

If pets are walked to school by parents the animal must be restrained at least 20 metres from school entrances.

Animals found on the school site will be reported to the Renmark Paringa Council and removed.

Animals used for curriculum purposes i.e fish, must be maintained according to Catholic Education Office guidelines. The welfare of the animal is paramount in utilising them in our curriculum.

PRINCIPLE:

Animals used for teaching purposes must be authorised by the Principal. (See attached proforma). It is expected that all necessary precautions have been undertaken to ensure the wellbeing of the students, staff and wider community.

Animals required to assist people in their daily lives i.e Guide dogs, shall be exempt.
